

Proposed Expenses for M-1 Students

The amounts below represent the minimum estimated expenses for *one year* at PC AGE Career Institute. *The budget does not allow for luxuries and you will want to have more money available, if possible. You must be able to prove that you can support these minimum annual expenses to be eligible for a Form I-20.*

TUITION AND SCHOOL FEES:

InterNetwork Engineering Tuition: \$19,500

School Fee: \$100

The College reserves the right, with no prior notice to restructure tuition and fee rates.

LIVING EXPENSES:

HOUSING AND UTILITIES \$6,400

This is based on the average cost of single (private) room in a shared house or apartment.

FOOD: \$1,800

PERSONAL NECESSITIES and CLOTHING: \$1,000

MEDICAL INSURANCE (OPTIONAL) \$1,000

TOTAL MINIMUM ANNUAL LIVING EXPENSES: \$10,200

DEPENDENT EXPENSES

Students planning to bring a spouse or children, or who have family now with them in the U.S., must show an additional \$3,000 per year to support the spouse and \$2,500 per year for each child. These amounts do not include the optional medical insurance.
